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Statistics

- 118 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 52% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 48% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Accommodations

- 1. Cognitive/Learning (49%)
- 2. Mental Health (44%)
- 3. Chronic Medical Conditions (19%)
- 4. Sensory (9%)
- 5. Other (7%)
- 6. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (4%)

Types of Student Disability Accommodations Provided

- 1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes (92%)
- 2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (43%)
- 3. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (35%)
- 4. Other accommodations (19%)
- 5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (5%)
- 6. Sign Language Interpreter and Captioned media (5%)
