- 113 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
  - 28% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
  - 72% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

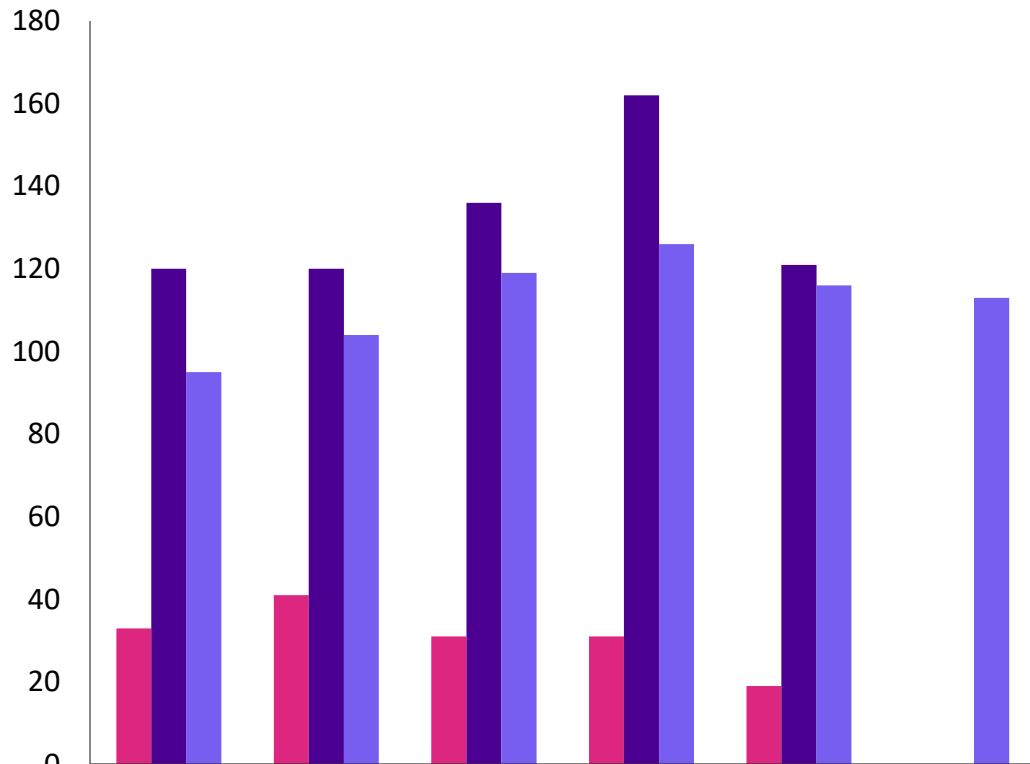
## Primary Student Disabilities

1. Mental Health (33%)
2. Cognitive/Learning (32%)
3. Sensory (14%)
4. Other (12%)
5. Chronic Medical Conditions (10%)
6. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (9%)

## Student Disability Accommodations Provided

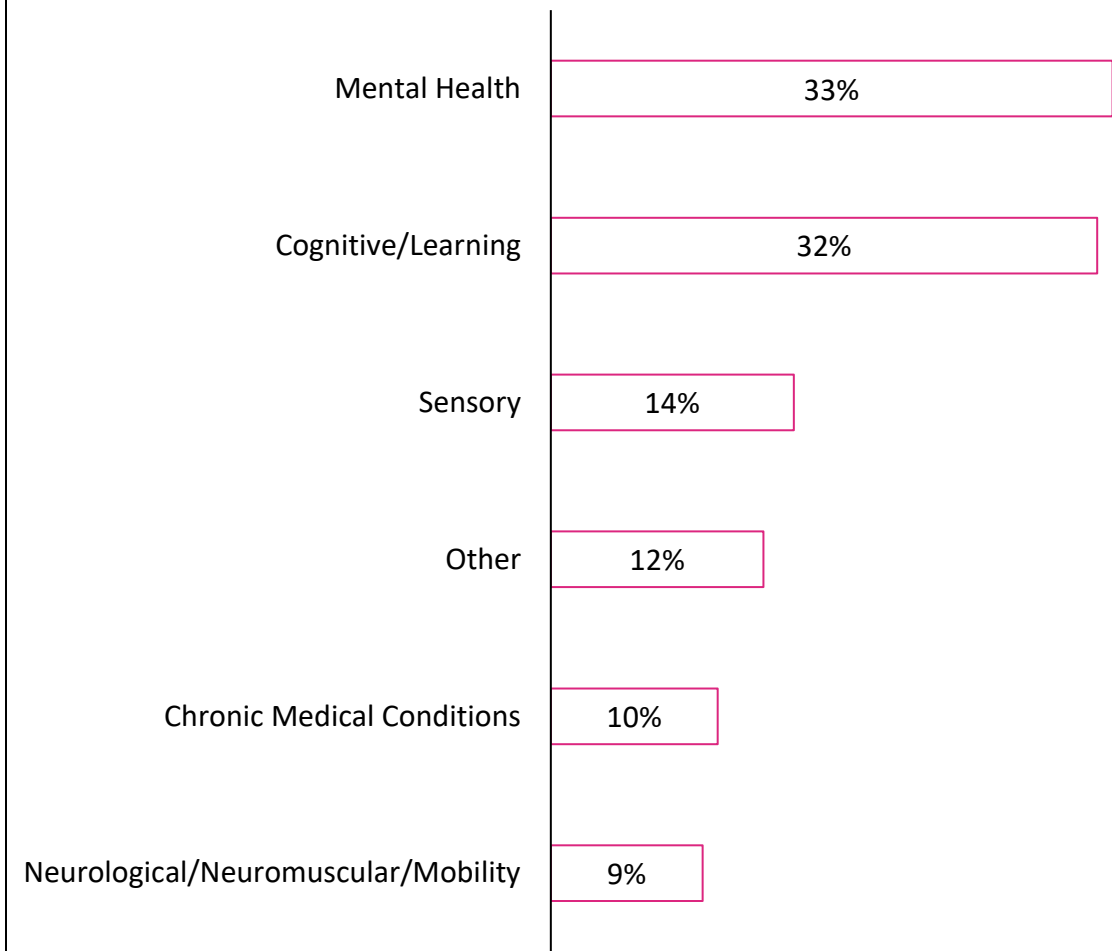
1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes, to be taken in a reduced-distraction setting (87%)
2. Other accommodations (33%)
3. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (31%)
4. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (26%)
5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (7%)
6. Captioned media (5%)
7. Sign Language interpreters (2%)
