

Spring 2020 Student Disability Services Data Report

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Statistics

- 113 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 28% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 72% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

Primary Student Disabilities

- 1. Mental Health (33%)
- 2. Cognitive/Learning (32%)
- 3. Sensory (14%)
- 4. Other (12%)
- 5. Chronic Medical Conditions (10%)
- 6. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (9%)

Student Disability Accommodations Provided

- 1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes, to be taken in a reduceddistraction setting (87%)
- 2. Other accommodations (33%)
- 3. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (31%)
- 4. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (26%)
- 5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (7%)
- 6. Captioned media (5%)
- 7. Sign Language interpreters (2%)
