CLASSROOM:

- Unsafe Driving Behaviors
- Safety Restraints
- Personal Responsibility

HANDS-ON:

- Shuffle Steering
- Backing & Cornering
- Off-road Recovery
- Collision Avoidance
- Skid Avoidance & Recovery

COURSE INFORMATION:

- Eight-hour course
- Limited to 20 students
- Cost is \$170 with personal vehicle (proof of insurance is required)
- Cost is \$220 using OSU-OKC vehicle
- Certificates awarded upon completion
- Call for course dates
