Statistics

- 69 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
 - 33% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
 - 67% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Accommodations

- 1. Cognitive/Learning (37%)
- 2. Mental Health (35%)
- 3. Chronic Medical Conditions (10%)
- 4. Other (9%)
- 5. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (7%)
- 6. Sensory (7%)

Types of Student Disability Accommodations Provided

- 1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and quizzes (97%)
- 2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (35%)
- 3. Other accommodations (22%)
- 4. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (22%)
- 5. Reader/Scribe on exams, quizzes, or inaccessible coursework (3%)
- 6. Captioned media (1%)
