#### **Statistics**

- 25 students are utilizing disability accommodations this semester.
  - o 40% are New Students who are utilizing accommodations for the first time at OSU-OKC.
  - 60% are Current/Returning Students who have utilized accommodations before at OSU-OKC.

## **Primary Disabilities of Students Utilizing Accommodations**

- 1. Cognitive/Learning (52%)
- 2. Mental Health (32%)
- 3. Chronic Medical Conditions (12%)
- 4. Sensory (12%)
- 5. Neurological/Neuromuscular/Mobility (8%)
- 6. Other (4%)

### Types of Student Disability Accommodations Provided

- 1. Extended time on timed tests, exams, and guizzes (92%)
- 2. Reasonable flexibility in attendance policies and/or coursework due dates in order to manage medical episodes or to attend health care appointments related to their disability (40%)
- 3. Permission to audio-record class lectures for note-taking purposes only (32%)
- 4. Other accommodations (16%)
- 5. Reader/Scribe on exams, guizzes, or inaccessible coursework (12%)
- 6. Sign Language Interpreter and Captioned media (4%)
