The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS), administered by the Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI), is a pre-entry examination used to assess the fundamental academic knowledge and skills of individuals applying to health science programs, such as nursing and sonography. The ATI-TEAS is an overall measure of general academic education.

**ATI-TEAS**

There are 170 multiple choice questions; however, 20 are unscored pretest questions. Questions are divided into four main subcategories:

Reading	The Reading section includes questions regarding paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension, and inferences/conclusions.	53	64
Mathematics	The Math section consists of problems involving metric conversion, whole numbers, fractions and decimals, percentages and ration/proportions, and algebraic equations.	36	54
Science	The Science section includes questions regarding science knowledge, science reasoning, chemistry, biology, anatomy and physiology, basic physical principles, and general science.	53	63
English and Language Usage	The English and Language section includes questions regarding punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, contextual words, and spelling.	28	28
