TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS:

- ◆ OSU-OKC awards tuition scholarships of various amounts to eligible applicants who are first-time entering, transfer or continuing students. **Full-time benefit employees of OSU-OKC are eligible for the Faculty/Staff Tuition Waiver.** These scholarships appear as reductions from university tuition charges.
- ◆ **Final awards can be made only to applicants who have been admitted in good standing to OSU-OKC.**
- ◆ Awards must be accepted within the time frame designated in the award letter or the offer may be rescinded. The scholarship must be used the first semester it is available and used continuously, with no breaks in attendance at OSU-OKC, or it will be rescinded.

FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION:

- ◆ Apply for Admission to OSU-OKC (New or Transfer Student) before submitting this completed application.
- ◆ Submit this application and required documents by **March 1** for fall consideration and **December 1** for spring.

An official copy of the high school transcript, ACT scores, Career Tech transcript, or college transcript (as applicable) must be attached to this application when submitted to the Financial Aid and Scholarship Office.

The priority deadlines for receipt of the Application for Scholarship are **March 1** for fall and **December 1** for spring.

Tuition waiver scholarship recipients must enroll in a **minimum of six credit hours** to be eligible for the scholarship award. All scholarships listed below are available to Oklahoma residents **ONLY**. All award amounts listed below are based on full-time enrollment. Award amounts will be prorated to match student enrollment level.

An eligible student may receive only **one** tuition scholarship.

All scholarships are awarded in the form of a tuition waiver.

Vice-President's Scholarship	Up to \$1,400 per year (\$700 fall and \$700 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 3.5 or minimum 23 ACT
Dean's Scholarship	Up to \$1,300 per year (\$650 fall and \$650 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 3.0 or minimum 22 ACT
