SIRS Government Reporter: Offers **full-text** government documents, articles, and Internet resources on a wide variety of topics. Databases include:

Original Sources: Offers **full-text** of original source material. Databases include:

INFOTRAC: Provides **full-text** access to nursing articles and citations. Databases include:

- Health Reference Center Academic
- Health and Wellness Resource Center

FirstSearch: Provides access to electronic indexes, but **does not provide full-text** of the articles indexed. It allows you to electronically request Interlibrary Loans for books or articles. Databases include:

- Article 1st
- MEDLINE
- WorldCat
- World Almanac
