- The OSU-Oklahoma City Library provides access to online databases for research 24-hours a day both on and off-campus.
- OSU-Oklahoma City provides wireless Internet access to students without charge.
- OSU-Oklahoma City has upgraded its main computer lab (TLC) to include more than 70 computers available to students more than 90 hours per week.
- The Technology Support Center in the Learning Resource Center is open more than 88 hours per week to solve students' technology issues.
- The Library has 16 laptop computers students can check out for use in the library (checked out 4083 times since purchase in 2005).
- OSU-Oklahoma City upgraded 66 of its 101 classrooms with Smart technology (computer, projector, document camera, sound system, and more)
- OSU-Oklahoma City's Online College Classroom uses Desire2Learn for its online course platform for 120+ unduplicated online courses each semester.
- OSU-Oklahoma City has an Internet Café for students' private study.

Methods Used to Monitor Technology Usage:

- The Library has means to check the number of times students access library databases by semester to determine usage.
- Students must check-in and check-out via computer technology whenever they enter and leave The Learning Center (TLC) computer lab.
- The Technology Support Center uses a Helpdesk ticket system to show which patrons' requests for service are still open, pending, or closed.
- The Library keeps track of laptop computer usage by a daily log.
- Information Services supports classroom technology issues through Helpdesk tickets processed in The Technology Support Center.
- Desire2Learn contains internal monitoring tools to track student and instructor use.
- The Internet Café is monitored by a student proctor, and the computers are monitored by Information Technology.
