This is a one-day, hands-on course developed to provide defensive driver training techniques to teen drivers. Students will engage in the Alive@25 classroom curriculum then complete hands-on vehicle training at the OSU-OKC PDTC.

Each driver will be taught the following modules:

classroom:

- ◆ Unsafe Driving Behaviors
- ◆ Safety Restraints
- ◆ Personal Responsibility

Hands-on:

- ◆ Shuffle Steering
- ◆ Backing & Cornering
- ◆ Off-road Recovery
- ◆ Collision Avoidance
- ◆ Skid Avoidance & Recovery

course information:

- ◆ One-day courses held monthly
- ◆ 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- ◆ Limited to 20 students
- ◆ Cost is \$125, with personal vehicle
- ◆ Insurance Reduction Certificate awarded upon completion

Participants must be between the ages of 15^{1/2} & 21, have basic driving experience and a learner's permit.
