The priority deadlines for receipt of the Application for Scholarship are **March 1** for fall and **December 1** for spring.

Tuition waiver scholarship recipients must enroll in a **minimum of six credit hours** to be eligible for the scholarship award. All scholarships listed below are available to Oklahoma residents **ONLY**. All award amounts listed below are based on full-time enrollment. Award amounts will be prorated to match student enrollment level.

An eligible student may receive only **one** tuition scholarship.

All scholarships are awarded in the form of a tuition waiver.

*Valedictorian/Salutatorian Scholarship	Full tuition up to 18 credit hours each fall and spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First-time student • Valedictorian or salutatorian designation by high school according to OSU-OKC scholarship eligibility rules
*President's Scholarship	Up to \$1,600 per year (\$800 fall and \$800 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 3.75 or minimum 24 ACT
Vice-President's Scholarship	Up to \$1,400 per year (\$700 fall and \$700 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 3.5 or minimum 23 ACT
Dean's Scholarship	Up to \$1,300 per year (\$650 fall and \$650 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 3.0 or minimum 22 ACT
Achievement Award Scholarship	Up to \$1,200 per year (\$600 fall and \$600 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum high school or college GPA of 2.5 or minimum 20 ACT
Non-traditional Student Scholarship	Up to \$1,200 per year (\$600 fall and \$600 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First-time college student who has been out of high school for more than one year. • 2.0 high school GPA or min 19 ACT
Access to Education Scholarship	Up to \$1,200 per year (\$600 fall and \$600 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consideration given to first-generation college students (neither parent has a four-year college degree) • High school graduate with a minimum high school GPA of 2.0 OR college student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 OR a GED recipient
Excellence in Technology Scholarship	Up to \$1,200 per year (\$600 fall and \$600 spring)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student with minimum GPA of 3.0 on all work completed at any Career Technology Center
